Class	Autumn
KS1	<p>Topics: <b>Terrific Transport</b> and for the next half term it will be <b>Let's Celebrate</b>.</p> <p>We have a daily phonics session and a writing session where we are focusing of fine motor skills in order to be able to hold a pencil. We read daily and work on developing our listening skills.</p>
Mrs L Edwards Y4/5 Pine	<p>Pine Class (yr 4/5) have a topic of '<b>schools</b>' for the first half term. We will be looking at 'Lunch Money (and other poems about school)', also 'Monsters not allowed', writing sections of stories and wanted posters.</p> <p>For the second half term the topic is '<b>London</b>'. We will be using, 'Katie in London', and looking at, 'Paddington' stories, attempting to write our own and instruction writing.</p>
Mrs O Hayford Y5 Rowan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Narrative, Fairy Tales.</li> <li>• Recounts and dictionary work.</li> <li>• Poetry - Pattern and Rhyme</li> </ul>
Mr P Lossasso/ Mr Hobbs Willow/Oak Y6	<p>Our topics this term will include a focus on <b>Fiction</b> - Fairy tales (e.g. Snow White or Sleeping Beauty) and Stories with familiar settings, also <b>Non-Fiction</b> - Explanations and Instructions (including writing &amp; following simple instructions) and <b>Poetry</b> - (Patterns on the Page). In addition to regular reading sessions, our phonics and spelling practice/tests are based on the Read Write Inc. programme and will help support sound and word building.</p>

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KS3

Mr C Harrison	The topic will be <b>Dinosaurs</b> Fiction with dinosaurs, inc. 'Harry and the bucketful of Dinosaurs'. Non-fiction facts/information about dinosaurs.
Miss L Woods	We will be studying <b>Instructions chronological reports, Performance Poetry and Christmas</b>
Mrs H Gadie	We will be reading and writing a <b>spooky story</b> using descriptive language. Reading and writing <b>instructions</b> using imperative verbs. In the second half of the term we will read the work of author <b>Michael Morpurgo</b> with particular focus on 'Butterfly Lion'

KS4

Mrs H Gadie/ Miss Paris ASDAN	Preparation for ASDAN Personal Progress in Developing Communication, Reading and Writing Skills. The topics will be: all about me, making choices labelling, sequencing fiction and non-fiction texts and the books we will look at are 'You Choose' and 'Room on the Broom'
Mr H Gadie Entry Level 2	Preparation for Entry Level qualification. Texts include non-fiction and fiction adventure texts and media campaigns. Skills will include reading and understanding; understanding how language and structure are used; inferring and comparing texts; planning, communicating effectively and editing own work.
Mr J Cartright Entry Level 1	<b>Base-line assessment</b> Letter / word recognition; sentence structures; spelling <b>Lost &amp; Found</b> Reading / Comprehension / sentence formation skills / Speaking & Listening exercises.

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<p>Mr J Cartright Entry Level 3</p>	<p><b>Stories with dilemmas</b> (6 weeks) This incorporates Reading / Comprehension / Questioning (written and spoken exercises) / Imaginative Role-Play (what happens next?) / Letter-writing</p> <p><b>Entry Level Reading Paper I</b> (5 weeks) Practice papers, leading to first controlled assessment in late November.</p> <p><b>Information Texts - Recycling</b> (4 weeks) Reading / Comprehension / Process mapping (how to recycle newspaper) Imaginative Role-Play (inquisitive questioning) / Letter-writing. Weekly spelling practice and tests</p>
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
