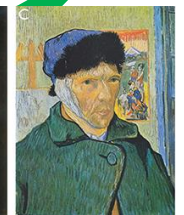
In year 10 students will learn about the 4 assessment objects for GCSE Art, by exploring ideas, materials and techniques.

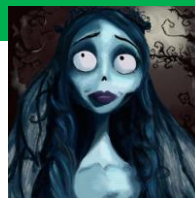
