Our Scheme of delegation outlines how this delegated responsibility works in practice. SENDAT Academies have the autonomy to:

1. Set their own curriculum.
2. Have input into the shape of their school's budget and medium term plan
3. Having spending autonomy within their planned budget.
4. Work with partners of their choice.

The ability to maintain a high level of autonomy through delegated responsibility is a key reason to consider joining SENDAT. Our aim is to support and challenge you to become even better. We recognise the importance of ownership in inspiring schools to achieve beyond their previous best.

What happens at Trust level?
